Clover Patch welcomes campers with disabilities, ages five and older. All prospective campers are evaluated individually and are enrolled pending physician's approval and appropriate screening by the Camp Director and medical advisors.

### **Camp Mission**

We are committed to meeting each camper's needs through continuous improvement and growth. We believe that through our commitment we possess the innovation, integrity and momentum to strengthen our services and provide each camper with the experience of a lifetime. We strive to create an atmosphere where campers and staff can develop life skills, self -confidence and personal freedom by creating new friends, new memories and new experiences.

## **Overnight Camp**

Clover Patch is available to children and adults who seek an overnight camping experience. Camp provides families and caregivers a period of reprieve while at the same time providing campers with a challenging, educational and enjoyable outdoor living experience in a fullyaccessible, natural setting.

### Day Camp

Clover Patch offers a day experience to children and adults who may not be ready for an overnight stay or have special twenty-four hour medical needs that would preclude them the overnight program. The day camp participants join in all the daily activities of the overnight campers, thus providing a wellrounded camp experience.

# Camp Staff

Thirty unique individuals comprise the Clover Patch team. Management heads up our team bringing experience from diverse backgrounds and our nursing staff have decades of experience at the Center for Disability Services. Eighteen direct care counselors, typically college-aged students in related fields, provide the personal care and assure that all the camper's needs are met. Every member of the team completes intensive training prior to camp. The camp community is enriched by staff members from across the country and around the world.
